



FORT BENITO CUB SCOUT DAY CAMP INFORMATION AND REGISTRATION FORMS CHECKLIST

We are so excited to have you join us at Fort Benito Cub Scout Day Camp! In this packet you will find all forms required for registration for both Parent and Cub Scout. ***Please read the important information below and retain this cover page for helpful reference.***

WHO CAN ATTEND?: Cub Scouts from Tigers (Friday only) to Arrow of Light may attend Camp. Campers MUST be currently registered as a Cub Scout with BSA to participate in Day Camp.

REGISTRATION DATES: Registration opens March 1st and closes on July 15th
Registration received after July 15th will be placed on a waitlist

Out-of-District Registration opens May 1st

- CAMP COST:**
- \$65 per Camper (PLUS one adult volunteer per family) thru July 15th
 - \$75 per Camper (PLUS one adult volunteer per family) after July 15th
 - \$95 per Camper (PLUS one adult volunteer per family) for Out-of-District registrants
 - ***Tigers: \$20 for our Friday-only Tiger Program***

What's Included: Camp T-shirt and Hat, Water bottle, Commemorative Camp Patch and Picture, Daily Snack, Craft/Activity Materials, Full-Time Medical Staff, Health & Accident Insurance, BSA-Trained Volunteer Staff, and Happy Camper memories for years to come!

Only Credit Cards accepted at www.fortbenito.com or cash/check are also accepted (make checks payable to BSA).

WHEN IS CAMP?: Camp is held from July 26 thru July 30th, 2020.
Camp Hours are from 9am to 3pm Monday thru Friday.

Please note that it is Day Camp policy and a ScoutsBSA guideline that Camp Staff cannot be responsible for your camper outside of official Camp hours. Please drop off and pick up your Cub Scout promptly. An authorized adult must check in each Cub Scout each morning and check him out at the end of each day.

WHERE IS CAMP?: Camp is held at Bolado Park County Fairgrounds in Tres Pinos, CA. (9000 Airline Highway)

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation to and from Day Camp is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. *We encourage car pools within your Pack or neighborhood. Please do not ask camp staff volunteers to provide transportation, as we need time before and after camp each day to set up and clean up. There will be only one entrance at Bolado Park into Day Camp and one exit. If you follow the signs, it will help with traffic problems and ensure the safety of all campers.*

PARENT PARTICIPATION: **Participating Packs must provide two full-time adult leaders for each group of five or less boys. All parents/guardians, current ScoutsBSA adult leaders or not, must volunteer for a Day Camp Staff position for a minimum of two (2) days or the equivalent of fourteen (14) hours during Camp.** While ALL help is appreciated, full time volunteers make the most worthwhile contribution to their child's Day Camp experience and make for the best quality Camp. This is a perfect opportunity to spend quality time helping a program that provides fun and advancement for your Scout(s) while setting a good example for a lifetime of service. Please seriously consider the most effective way to contribute your special talents and time.

**WHAT TO BRING
& WHAT TO WEAR:**

- ✓ A sack lunch daily with name on it, except for the day that he/she cooks (you will be notified ahead of time). *Any dietary restrictions must be noted on the ScoutsBSA Health and Medical Record Part A and B.*
- ✓ A towel and swimsuit for Aquatics (you will be notified which day your child will be swimming).
- ✓ Aqua socks or a change of shoes for Aquatics and Nature Hike days only (muddy & wet feet may happen).
- ✓ Sunscreen. Apply first at home prior to Camp.
- ✓ A sweatshirt/jacket for unpredictably chilly weather. ***Name must be on all belongings brought to Camp.***
- ✓ Money for Trading Post if desired, but only a few dollars, please!

Your child will be given a plastic water bottle with their name on it to keep at Camp for all-day hydration. *Water bottles will be washed and sanitized by Camp Staff for your child daily.*

Cub Scouts will be given a commemorative t-shirt and hat on the first day of Camp, **both to be worn every day as the official Day Camp uniform.**

Campers must come to Camp wearing closed-toed shoes for safety - NO SANDALS will be permitted at Camp.

KIDDIE KORRAL:

FREE* childcare is offered for the younger children of adult leaders only when the parent is volunteering for a shift at Camp. If you will be utilizing Kiddie Korral, you must fill out the Kiddie Korral Registration Form and the ScoutsBSA Health and Medical Record Parts A and B for each child who will be in childcare. Extra forms will be available at the Adult Staff Training. Kiddie Korral is managed by adults above the age of 18 and may use the help of youth staff. ScoutsBSA two-deep leadership is followed at all times.

*A donation of one NEW puzzle, toy, book or piece of child care-related equipment is requested, due the first day of Camp.
